Welcome and Updates

ZM welcomed the reps and introduced DD and DH. ZM explained the Academic Council would run slightly different as the Students' Union would be running a focus group with the reps.

Rep Feedback

SEATs – Still ongoing issues around the app such as QR codes coming up as invalid. Some lecturers going back to using paper registers however, are forgetting to manually update the app effecting students attendance. ZM will bring this up to SLT and the IT department again.

QMU Merch – Nursing reps feedback around the lack of returns policy making it difficult to exchange or return the wrong items that were delivered. Issues were wrong colours and zips being on the wrong side. ZM and DD will follow up with the University staff around this.

Plug sockets – Many classes unable to access the plug sockets in the classrooms due to being locked. ZM to follow up with the university.

Class Rep Focus Group then followed after the reps gave their feedback.

Other comments

Challenges around PATs depending on course / lecturer.

Class reps struggling to get cohort feedback as the year progresses.

Reps would like clearer roles and responsibilities to pass round their class.
