NUS UK SURVEY

Campus Life Forum 31st January 2019

Officers asked students their views on the National Union of Students during this Campus Life Forum. 38 students filled out the survey.

Overall students at QMU have poor knowledge of how NUS can benefit them or their Students' Union and few of them have already taken part in NUS activities.

Survey results:

52.63% students at QMU know their Students' Union is member of NUS 10.53% students at QMU know how NUS membership benefits them 5.26% students at QMU know how NUS membership benefits their Students' Union 10.53% students at QMU know of present or past NUS campaign 10.53% students at QMU have been involved with some of NUS work

Students who know how NUS benefits them only referred to benefits from Totum Card. A few students acknowledged having heard of some NUS campaigns (e.g. housing, LGBT, Budget for Better) but not knowing details of the campaigns. One student expressed concerns with regards to the use of financial resources in conferences and fair representation to The Students' Union.
