

We always strive to make our students feel like they are part of a **community**, by supporting them and **celebrating their achievements** through the year.

The S&S **Grand Ball** had 571 attendees at the 02 Academy, Edinburgh. This event saw 17 team/committee awards and over 50 individual awards handed out on the night.

This year we held our **STaR Awards** Ceremony in March.

We received 149 nominations for 96 nominees and 14 awards were handed out to staff and students who have gone above and beyond to make the student experience the best it can be.

To support students through the cost of living crisis, we joined forces with QMU and held weekly **TGIThursday** nights, where students got free hot meals served by staff as well as a meal kit to take home. Over **5600 meals** were served through the year.

We also supported the **QMU Food Pantry** which has been visited over 1300 times and has given out 1657 bags of food.

We provide students with **extra-curricular opportunities** which support academic learning and **fun** outside of studying, like our Sports & Societies.

All of our Clubs and Societies put so much effort in to making sure that their student members had a great experience this year.

- Our performing arts societies hosted showcases, performances and events at QMU and in external venues.
- The **Give it a Go Fair** had 980 student visits where they had the chance to try out various S&S before committing to a membership.
- Varsity was held in March where the overall result was closer than previous years and many QMU students came along on the day to support our Teams.
- Women's Basketball made it all the way to the Scottish Conference Cup final.
- Dance won Overall Best Team at the Silver City Competition in Aberdeen.
- Movember raised a massive £16000 with the help of our S&S.

We have an elected Officer's Committee and a **student-led Trustee Board**. We held our annual **elections** in March this year where QMU students cast 3220 votes to elect the Officers and ensure that the student voice is heard.

Among other things, our Officers have successfully advocated for the Moderator email communications to be replaced with **Student Weekly News** which is sent to QMU students only once per week.

Scottish Government, BUCS, SSS.

We operate in and promote a culture of **respect** for all students, staff and visitors. We always aim to be **inclusive** and to take care of our community.

QMU and the SU joined forces to host a ground breaking (meno)Pausitivity @ QMU day. Staff and students wore a 'menovest' which simulates hot flushes and helps to build understanding and empathy of what many women experience in their workplaces and personal lives. The day was a huge success and featured on STV news.

The **HelpZone** advised over 300 students on University and Welfare matters both online and in person.

3500+ **free condoms** given out by our C:Card Service and we continue to provide free sustainable period products.

We held 6 **Engaging the Bystander** sessions for approximately 30 students. These sessions raise awareness of sexual assault and discuss how being an active bystander can reduce the number of sexual assaults.
